CivicReady Emergency

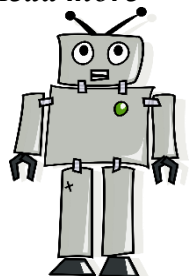
Marion Township is inviting all of its residents to participate in our new emergency alerting system. The system is intended to be used for emergency alerts, as well as non-emergency incidents.

Emergency Alerts could be related to specific hazards that require some kind of action be taken such as evacuation or shelter in place,

Non-emergency alerts could include significant transportation problems with prolonged impacts or significant ongoing police or fire activity. In addition to receiving information on your wireless device, you may also receive notification on your land telephone line (if you have one) depending on the type of incident or event.

Attention Dog Owners!

All dogs 3 months of age and older are required to have a dog License. Failure to have a current dog license may result in a fine of up to \$300 per dog. You can obtain a license online at Countyofberks.com or call 610-478-6640. All pets must be on a leash and in full control of the responsible party. *Waste material must be picked up by responsible party.*

Grass Clippings & Debris



Please sweep up grass clippings from your property. If you employ a third party to mow your lawn, please make sure they keep clippings in your yard and not in the street. It is important to keep debris & clippings from being washed away with storm water & obstructing storm drains and contaminating waterways. Also, the grass height restrictions are 6 inches. We appreciate your help in keeping grass trimmed at or below 6 inches to remain compliant.

Fireworks and alcohol in the park are illegal.



Please keep in mind that per Pennsylvania Law:

Fireworks are not allowed to be ignited or discharged on public or private property without express permission of the property owner.

Fireworks cannot be discharged within 150' from any building or vehicle regardless if the building is owned by the user.

Fireworks cannot be discharged while the person is under the influence of alcohol.

Fireworks and Alcohol are not permitted in the Township Park and remember, the park is closed from dusk to dawn.

PLEASE RINSE ALL CONTAINERS BEFORE RECYCLING

Marion Township residents may dispose of one (1) bulk item per week through curb side collection. Please have your waste, recycling and bulk item available for collection at the curb by 5:00 am

Accepted Materials: Paper & Cardboard (**No books, shredded paper, contaminated pizza boxes**). Wax cartons: Milk, Juice, Soup, Flavored Drinks and Cartons can be recycled. Aluminum. Glass (**No window glass, mirrors or light bulbs**). Plastics #1-#7 (no toys, Styrofoam, or ceramics). Flexible Plastic Packaging (**Plastic wrap properly rinsed**).

Bulk Items: You can put out one (1) bulk item per week. If you wish to put out mattresses or box springs, they **MUST** be wrapped in plastic for pick up.

Additional Instructions: Items: No tanks, tires, drums, automobile parts, riding mowers, or any item that contains fluids or fuels. Items that contain Freon or CFC's must have freon or gas removed and be tagged by a professional removal service before disposal.
