

ORDINANCE NO. 1995-5

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MARION, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT ON PORTIONS OF CANAL ROAD, HOST ROAD, WOODS DRIVE, KATTERMAN HILL ROAD, SMALTZ ROAD, CHURCH ROAD, EDRIS DRIVE, AND CHARMING FORGE ROAD, AND ESTABLISHING A STOP INTERSECTION ALONG HICKORY ROAD AT BOLLINGER ROAD IN MARION TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Marion, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby Enacted and Ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

1. Pursuant to the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, 75 Pa. C.S. 3363, and upon the basis of a traffic and engineering investigation of the following Township roads, it is determined that the current thirty-five (35) miles per hour and fifty-five (55) miles per hour speed limits on the following sections of roadway is unreasonable and unsafe under the conditions found to exist upon said roadways and that a maximum speed limit hereinafter set forth is herein established for said sections of roadway as a reasonable and safe maximum speed limit and therefore, it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle on said roadways at a speed higher than the maximum hereinafter prescribed for that section of roadway:

2. Any person who violates any provision of Section 1 above shall, upon conviction of a summary offense, be sentenced to pay a fine of Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) and costs, or as otherwise provided under the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code as it may be amended hereafter, plus any applicable surcharge as may be imposed under the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, as amended. Any person exceeding the maximum speed limit by more than five (5) miles per hour shall pay an additional fine of Two Dollars (\$2.00) per mile for each mile in excess of five (5) miles per hour over the maximum speed limit, or as otherwise provided in the Vehicle Code as it may be amended hereafter.

3. Pursuant to the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, 75 Pa. C.S. 3323, and upon the basis of a traffic and engineering investigation it is herein determined that the following intersection be established as a stop intersection, and official stop signs shall be erected (or are ratified if previously

erected) in such a position as to face traffic approaching the second-named street (the through street) on the first-named street (the stop street) in the direction or directions indicated for that intersection. Every driver of a vehicle approaching the intersection on the first-named or stop street, in the direction indicated in each case, shall stop the vehicle as required by Section 3323(b) of the Vehicle Code, and shall not proceed into or across the second-named or through street until he has followed all applicable requirements of that section of the law.

4. Any person who violates any provision of section 3 above shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) and costs, or as otherwise provided under the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code as it may be amended hereafter.

5. It is hereby declared that the enactment of this ordinance is necessary for the protection, benefit, and preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of Marion Township.

6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

7. This ordinance shall become effective five (5) days

after the date of its enactment.
