

ORDINANCE NO. 1995-6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MARION TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO INCREASE THE COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ENTERING INTO OFFICE ON OR AFTER JANUARY 2, 1996.

The following ordinance is hereby adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Marion Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted Act \_\_\_ of 1995, setting forth certain guidelines and limitations for the compensation of supervisors of townships of the second class, and

WHEREAS, said act provides that supervisors of townships having a population of 4,999 may be compensated in an amount not to exceed \$1,875.00 per year, and

WHEREAS, the population of Marion Township is under 4,999, and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly by said Act \_\_\_ authorizes the board of supervisors of the various townships of the second class to determine the compensation of supervisors subject to the limitations set forth in the act,

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Marion Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby Enacted and Ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

1. Each supervisor of Marion Township entering into office on or after the effective date of this ordinance shall receive compensation for attending duly advertised general or special public meetings or hearings of the board of supervisors, or other meetings authorized by the board of supervisors at the rate of \$60.00 for each meeting attended by such supervisor, not to exceed \$1,875.00 per year.

2. Such compensation shall be paid in monthly or quarterly installments.

3. This ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after the date of its enactment.
