

ORDINANCE NO. 2008-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MARION TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1993-2 PERTAINING TO OPEN FIRES AND BURNING IN MARION TOWNSHIP BY DELETING PAPER PRODUCTS AND CARDBOARD AS ITEMS WHICH MAY BE BURNED.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Marion Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:


1. Section 3.2.A of Ordinance No. 1993-2 pertaining to restricting open fires and burning within Marion Township is herein amended by deleting the reference to paper products and cardboard as items which may be burned.

2. Severability. If any sentence clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not effect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of Marion Township that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalid sentence clause, section or part thereof had not been included herein.

This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after the date of its enactment.




